As requested in your discussion with Rick Buckley of our Entergy corporate office on June 10, 1999, we are attaching the correspondence submitted by your office on August 17, 1992 approving closure of the underground storage tanks at River Bend Station (RBS). 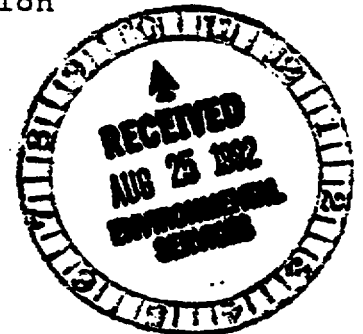

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
