Dear Mr. Plunkett:

On July 2, 1999, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued amendment No. 162 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-67 for the St. Lucie Plant, Unit 1 and Amendment No. 102 for Unit 2. These amendments were issued in response to your application dated December 1, 1997, as supplemented August 26, 1999. Page 5 of the Safety Evaluation, fourth paragraph, Section 4.2.4, *Light Screen to Minimize Turtle Disorientation*, stated, "The requirement for the shielding perimeter lights from Unit 1 License Condition 2.F.(1) will be deleted from the Unit 1 license. . . ." This specific change was inadvertently excluded from the Unit 1 Amendment.

Page 2 of Unit 1 Amendment No. 162, the list of affected page numbers, and page 4 of Facility Operating License No. DPR-67, have been corrected to include this change. Copies of the corrected pages are enclosed.

- 1) ~~The licensee will plant Australian pine or other suitable plants as a light screen along the beach dune line bordering its property to minimize turtle disorientation.
