Dear Sir:

In Reference 1, the Authority submitted two summary reports documenting the results of the Authority's program to resolve Unresolved Safety Issue (USI) A-46 at the Indian Point 3 Nuclear Power Plant. USI A-46 deals with the seismic adequacy of mechanical and electrical equipment in operating reactors. In Reference 1, the Authority also committed to resolve all the remaining outliers, that were identified in the summary reports, prior to startup from refueling outage (RO) 10.

The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC that the Authority has resolved all the remaining outliers. These were resolved prior to startup from RO 10 (the outage ended on October 21, 1999).

The Authority is making no new commitments in this letter.
