**PROGRAM MANAGEMENT INFORMATION: TECHNICAL CONFERENCING FORUM -
 REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON PRE-DECISIONAL DRAFT INSPECTION MANUAL
 TEMPORARY INSTRUCTION, "VERIFICATION OF THE STATUS OF DEVICES
 AUTHORIZED FOR USE UNDER A GENERAL LICENSE" (SP-99-)**

In All Agreement State letters SP-97-084, dated December 9, 1997, and SP-99-019, dated March 26, 1999, we described that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) primary means of distribution of pre-decisional and other documents of interest to Agreement States is the electronic subsystem that has been established for sole use by the Agreement States. This subsystem is under the Technical Conference Forum (TCF) of the NRC Home Page. The TCF subsystem can only be accessed by the Agreement States having an unique user name and password, which were last updated via All Agreement State letter SP-97-027.

The Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards has uploaded to the TCF a draft NRC Inspection Manual Temporary Instruction entitled "Verification of the Status of Devices Authorized for Use Under a General License." Your review and comment is invited on the draft Technical Instruction by **December 17, 1999**. Please provide comments to the extent you can either through the TCF or to the individual named below. We are especially interested in having your comments on identifying resources you would employ, and descriptions of the methods, (i.e., such as flow charts) you believe would be most effective in locating missing licensees. Additionally, comments on how many person-hours should be dedicated to the location of each class of device would be useful.

Due to its pre-decisional nature, this document is exempt from public disclosure under NRC rules. We request that you limit distribution to your staff and not release the document publicly. If this document is released, please inform **me or the individual named below within 24 hours**. The Draft Temporary Instruction can be accessed through the TCF subsystem at <http://techconf.llnl.gov/cgi-states/topics>, using your appropriate user name and password.
