

Dear Mr. Bell:

In order to maintain levels of discharges from our decontamination facility as low as is reasonably achievable, Babcock & Wilcox has provided engineering support to the facility to determine what additional processing must be done before releasing the liquid wastes. The engineering study has shown that the addition of equipment needed before we can release our liquids from this facility to the Kiski Valley Water Pollution Control Authority will be installed prior to March 1, 1977.
