I have received your request dated August 24, 1994 to acquire a portion of the sample of the above referenced incinerator ash. As I have subsequently discussed with Randy Ragland, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources has 1,000 kg of ash that was accumulated during the composite sampling of the lagoon on March 24, 1994, and is willing to assist you in your request. This sample has been legal sealed and secured in my possession from the sampling date until August 30, 1994. On this date, I sent the two (2) 500 milliliter containers to Mr. Ragland. As the attached report and site map indicates, this sample represents the upper six feet of ash in the lagoon.

I await your radioactivity analysis and will forward our radium results to Mr. Ragland when they become available from the D.E.R. lab.
