This is a follow-up to my original report of Aug. 5, 1999. In that report I erroneously indicated that the Physics Department received the natural uranium in 1970. That was the date of a paper transfer only. The actual material was received in 1960.

A review of our records indicate that the last inventory of the uranium sources was conducted in 1980 and indicated that all sources were present. This was the last year in which I was actively involved in running the laboratory.

I have conducted a thorough search of the Physics Department's facilities and have found no trace of the four missing uranium slugs. On Aug. 16, 1999 I sent a memorandum describing the loss to those individuals with offices in Pope Hall, the most recent site for the lab, those with offices in Gannon Hall, the previous lab site, and former employees of the Physics Department who had access to the lab. All of the memo recipients have responded and none of them indicated any knowledge of the missing sources. I have no information as to the final disposition of these four slugs.

Recurrence of such a loss or theft is not an issue since the College is terminating all of its NRC licensed activities. If I can provide any further information, please contact me.
