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SUBJECT: JOSEPH M. FARLEY NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2 — ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENTS RE: FILTRATION SYSTEM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS (TAC NOS. MA4943 AND MA4944)

Dear Mr. Morey:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 145 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-2 and Amendment No. 136 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-8 for the Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. The amendments consists of changes to the Technical Specifications and associated Bases in response to your application dated June 30, 1997, as supplemented by letters dated February 22, March 19, June 30, and October 4, 1999.

The amendments clarify surveillance requirements for the control room emergency filtration system, penetration room filtration system, and related storage pool ventilation system. The changes would also revise the required number of radiation monitoring instrumentation channels and would delete the containment purge exhaust filter Technical Specifications.

A copy of the related Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. A Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's biweekly *Federal Register* notice.
