Subject: RECOVERED PORTABLE GAUGE

The Florida Bureau of Radiation Control notified NRC that the licensee (Professional Engineering and Inspection Company, Inc.) had recovered the missing Troxler gauge. The licensee was subsequently notified, and the gauge was picked up by the licensee during the morning of December 2, 1999. The licensee reported that the gauge was not damaged.
