
Dear Ms Dedik/Ms Wright

I have been advised by the Australian company SILEX Systems of a shipment they expect to receive shortly from USEC. The transfer will be of about 15 kilograms of UF6 enriched to 10% U-235.

This is to confirm that SILEX Systems has a Permit (PN144) issued by this Office to possess and use nuclear material (NM) as described above. Receipt of the material will be reported to the IAEA and accounted for to the USA pursuant to the Australia/USA Agreement Concerning Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy. Physical protection will be afforded the NM according to the provisions of INFCIRC/225/Rev.3, or any later revisions adopted by Australia.
