SUBJECT: OCTOBER 1999 REPORT ON THE STATUS OF PUBLIC PETITIONS
 UNDER 10 CFR 2.206

The attached monthly report gives the status of 10 CFR 2.206 petitions as of October 31, 1999. During October, the Director's Decision (DD-99-13) on Nine Mile Point (G19990224) was issued, and the petition was closed. One new petition (G19990488) on San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) was received. Thus, there are five open petitions: four in NRR and one in NMSS.

Attachment 1 provides the status of petitions for the Offices of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) and Nuclear Reactor Regulation (NRR). Attachment 2 gives the status of petitions that are in a confidential status and for internal distribution only. Attachment 3 shows the age and staff hours expended on open 2.206 petitions as of October 31, 1999, including a summary of the status of 2.206 petitions exceeding the 120-day scheduled completion goal. Attachment 4 shows the statistics for the 2.206 petitions processed during 1999.
