Enclosed is an application for a license (XSOU8774), recently received by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, for the export of 50,000.0 kilograms of thorium, contained in 60,000 kilograms of thorium oxides, nitrates, and other thorium compounds for Tig welding as a material in electrodes for electric discharging lamps and for production of thoriated tungsten rods. These are non-nuclear end uses.

We will issue the license after the required waiting period.
