Sir:

I am writing to urge the Commission to adopt the Proposed Rule #1 and the Proposed Rule #2 concerning limits of employee working hours in Nuclear Plants, and training on employee protection regulations to supervisors, managers, and directors.

The limitation of working hours by federal regulation has been used to protect the public in the case of airline employees and of truck drivers. The consequences of fatigue-caused errors in a nuclear power plant can be enormous.

Employees must feel free to report violations to the commission, for the protection of the public. A training course for supervisory personnel should be required to inform them of their duties and personal responsibilities in regard to such reporting and "whistle blowing".
