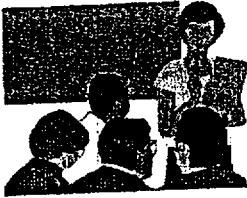

On 11/30/99 an incident took place on an inland barge rig located in the Sweetlake area of Cameron Parish in Louisiana. A well logging tool became stuck down hole on a rig operated by Spirit Energy 76. The tool, owned by Haliburton, contained 2 sources. The first source was a 4 ci AmBe 241 source that is located at 9717 measured depth. The second source is a 2ci Cs 137 source which is located at 9727 measured depth. Several efforts were made to try to recover the tool but were unsuccessful. On 12/4/99 the State of Louisiana granted permission to plug an abandon the sources.
