
Subject Docket No. 50-482: Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation Response to NRC Inspection Report 99-09.

Gentlemen

NRC Inspection Report 99-09, Docket No. 50-482, dated October 7, 1999, documents an inspection conducted during the period-of August 30 through September 3, 1999, pertaining to the operational status of the emergency preparedness program. The letter stated that Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) management ". . . would revise the station emergency plan to resolve differences identified between the plan and 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, and would provide a proposed date for completion of the plan revision." A proposed revision is currently in progress. Provided the evaluations, performed in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q), do not identify a reduction in the effectiveness in the plan, the proposed revision will be released by December 30, 1999. The plan will be submitted to the NRC within 30 days of release in accordance with 10 CFR 50, Appendix E.
