
I retired just two years ago and my wife and I moved to Plymouth, MA. We were made aware of the proximity of the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Plant soon after arriving. Being within the zone which would be affected by any release of radiation from the plant, we are most interested in its continued safe operation.

We have learned about two proposed rules for safer plant operation which the commission is studying: # 1 establishes limits on employee working hours at any plant and # 2 provides for required training of management and supervisory personnel with respect to protecting employees from retribution by such personnel when the employee reports a problem.

Considering the history of nuclear plant accidents, both inside and outside of the United States, it seems to us that these two rules should have been in effect long ago. If they have not, we feel strongly that their adoption is necessary.

We urge the commission to put both rules into effect at the earliest possible moment.
