Dear Chairman Richard Meserve:

I am very concerned about the proposed process of legalizing a massive release of metal, plastic, concrete and other materials from commercial nuclear power plants and DOE weapons facilities for use in household products.

You have the responsibility to prevent the dissemination of radioactive wastes into general commerce. You have the responsibility to protect citizens by denying this legalization of use in household products, especially without proper labeling of the products. The public must know in order to make an informed choice of which products to purchase.

The fact that it is difficult and expensive to monitor and protect radioactive waste does not justify its release. I urge your commission to consider all consequences before deciding to allow the use of nuclear power plant and weapons facilities materials to be used in household products.
