SUBJECT: XSOU-8774 EXPORT OF THORIUM TO JAPAN

We have reviewed the proposed amendment and have no international safeguards concerns. Pursuant to 10 CFR Part 110.42(c), there is no specific export requirement for the application of IAEA safeguards to source material destined for non-nuclear end use. The review of license applications for the export of byproduct material and for source material for non-nuclear end uses is governed by the criterion that the proposed export is not inimical to the common defense and security.

There are no physical protection requirements applicable to the subject export.

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SUBJECT: XSOU-8742, EXPORT OF THORIUM TO THE KYRGYZ REPUBLIC

We have reviewed the proposed amendment and have no international safeguards concerns.
