SUBJECT: REFERRAL OF ISSUE FROM THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR
GENERAL

On October 29, 1999, I received the attached memoranda and letters from the Office of the Inspector General (OIG) referring issues received by the OIG to the staff for appropriate followup. I am referring the incoming letters to you because the subject matter does not meet the definition of an allegation. In the September 10, 1999 letter, the author expresses dissatisfaction with the response to her 2.206 petition.
