
Dear Mr. Maynard:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 131 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-42 for the Wolf Creek Generating Station. The amendment consists of changes to the improved Technical Specifications (ITS) in response to your application dated November 8, 1999 (ET 99-0047).

The amendment corrected 15 errors in the improved Technical Specifications that was issued in Amendment No. 123 on March 31, 1999.
