Dear Mr. Collins:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that the sale and transfer of Clinton Power Station (CPS) from Illinois Power (IP) to AmerGen Energy Company, LLC (AmerGen) has been completed effective as of 12:01 a.m. Central Standard Time on December 15, 1999. In accordance with the CPS Asset Purchase Agreement executed by IP and AmerGen, IP has transferred its interest in CPS to AmerGen and AmerGen has assumed operating authority for CPS.

Please note that this letter also satisfies Condition #2 of the AmerGen Energy Company, LLC, Clinton Power Station, Quality Assurance Program approval for Radioactive Material Packages, Approval Number 0624, Revision 3, dated August 30, 1999. Condition #2 requires that the closing date of the transfer of assets from Illinois Power Company to AmerGen Energy Company, LLC be formally communicated to the NRC.
