SUBJECT: Limerick Generating Station (LGS), Units 1 and 2
Notification of Change in Operator Status

Gentlemen:

Please disregard our letter of September 22, 1999 that requested suspension of participation in requalification training for two SROs. PECO Energy is currently requesting that these SRO licenses be terminated.

Therefore, this letter provides a followup notification in accordance with 10CFR50.74; Notification of change in operator status. 10CFR50.74 specifies that "Each licensee shall notify the Commission in accordance with 50.4 within 30 days of the following in regard to a licensed operator or senior operator; 50.74(a) Permanent reassignment from the position for which the licensee has certified the need for a licensed operator or senior operator under 55.31(a)(3)".

The following operators have been reassigned to duties that do not require maintaining licensed operator status. It has been determined that these operators will not be attending requalification training. It is possible that PECO Energy may request reinstatement of these licenses within the following two year period. We understand an abbreviated re-licensing process would apply during this period.


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As a result of these assignments these licenses are no longer necessary as originally certified under 10CFR55.31(a)(3).
