Dear Ms. Blossom:

I have been asked to respond to your letter dated October 12, 1999, to former Chairman Dicus, expressing your concerns about the continued operation of the Millstone nuclear power plants. I would like to address your concerns arising from the New York Times article dated September 28, 1999, which reported the record fine the Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) agreed to pay as a result of their guilty plea to 25 felony counts.

As the same article points out, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) ordered the Millstone plants to shut down as a result of some of the very problems you cited. During this period, not only were there investigations, which resulted in the historic fines, but the NRC also established a special oversight organization in the NRC Region I office and at NRC headquarters to inspect and follow the licensee's progress and efforts to address and correct management and technical problems that NRC inspectors had uncovered. The extent of the problems and the corrective actions, which eventually led to the Commission decision to allow the restart of Millstone Unit 3 and later Unit 2, are well documented in reports, public meetings, and Commission meetings. 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
