On October 28, 1999, James P. Dwyer of this office conducted a safety inspection at your facility of activities authorized by the above listed NRC license. The inspection was limited to a review of a potential medical misadministration which occurred at your facility on October 27, 1999, and which was reported to NRC by Mr. Robert Tokarz of your staff later that same day. The findings of the inspection were discussed with Mr. Tokarz at the conclusion of the inspection.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified. In addition, NRC determined that the October 27, 1999 event resulted from patient intervention and therefore the event does not qualify as a medical misadministration.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules and Practices," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room. No reply to this letter is required.
