I am writing on behalf of the Sierra Club Miami Group over grave concerns we have over the continuing operation of the Turkey Point Nuclear Power Plant. As you probably know, Miami-Dade County has plans to redevelop the former Homestead Air Force Base ("HAFB") into a major commercial airport. We feel that many safeguards must be in place at Turkey Point before commercial usage at Homestead begins.

Would you please send to us the following:

- 1) The response by Florida Power & Light to your letter of April 14, 1998.
- 2) The update to the Final Safety Analysis Report and "other relate documents" mentioned in your letter of May 4, 1998 to Ms. Joette Lorion of Friends of the Everglades
- 3) The NRC's review and conclusions to Florida Power & Light's response.
- 4) The responses from the Sate of Florida, mentioned in the letter dated December 20, 1996 to me from Stewart Ebnetter, Regional Administrator.
- 5) The responses from the Federal Emergency Management Agency from the same letter dated December 20, 1996.
- 6) Any other documents related to safety issues at Turkey Point concerning the Miami-Dade's proposed development of a commercial airport at the former HAFB.

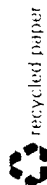
