LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATIONS - REVISION OF SCHEDULE

On June 3, 1999, Virginia Electric and Power Company (Virginia Power) notified the Commission of the intent to concurrently submit license renewal applications for Surry and North Anna Power Stations. The tentative schedule for submittal of these applications was identified as March 2002.

In view of the continued progress made by the lead plants in definition and standardization of the license renewal process and our plant specific progress to date, we have reconsidered our submittal schedules for Surry and North Anna. Consequently, Virginia Power intends to revise the schedule for submittal of license renewal applications for both Surry and North Anna Power Stations to September 2001.
