Dear Mr. Myers:

The staff has completed its review of your responses to Generic Letter (GL) 97-06, "Degradation of Steam Generator Internals." The primary purpose of GL 97-06 was to obtain information that would enable the staff to verify that the condition of the BVPS Units 1 and 2 steam generator internals comply with and conform to the current licensing basis for their respective units. The staff's review of your responses to the GL did not identify any new concerns with the condition of the steam generator internals. The staff also did not identify any concerns with the inspection practices employed at BVPS Units 1 and 2 to detect steam generator internals degradation. Thus, the staff concludes your responses to the GL provide reasonable assurance that the condition of your steam generator internals are in compliance with the current licensing basis for BVPS Units 1 and 2. The detailed technical basis that supports this determination will be published in a NUREG report. The expected publication date is December 1999.


