Response to NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-04

NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2000-04, "Operating Reactor Licensing Action Estimates," requested that licensees on a voluntary basis to provide an estimate of the number of licensing actions expected to be submitted for NRC's review in the remaining Fiscal Year (FY) 2000 and FY 2001, and to identify by brief title those licensing actions that are expected to generate complex reviews.

At this time, there are 21 potential licensing actions per docket planned for FY 2000 and FY 2001, for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4.

The following three potential licensing actions are expected to generate complex reviews during this period:

1. Creating a Sequencer specific Technical Specification,
2. Generating revised Pressure/Temperature curves and cold Overpressure mitigation system setpoints for placement into the Technical Specifications, and
3. License renewal for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4.
