SUBJECT:	POLICY AND GUIDANCE DIRECTIVE (PG) 1-27, "REVIEWING REQUESTS TO CONVERT ACTIVE LICENSES TO POSSESSION-ONLY LICENSES"

In accordance with your memo dated February 22, 2000, we have reviewed the 20 licenses which have the old possession-only program codes 03800, 11800, and 23300, authorizing "storage only". Of these, only two meet the criteria for the new "standby" program codes 03810, 11810, or 23310. A list of the licenses reviewed, indicating those which need to be changed, is attached.

In accordance with your memo, we plan to send a letter to each of the two licensees to inform them of the new category for licenses, called "standby-no operations," that have temporarily suspended operations rather than permanently ceased operations. The letter will inform them that we will change our records to reflect their status as in "standby-no operations" after 30 days from the date of the letter, and that this change may result in the assessment of an annual fee.

The PG 1-27 requires changes to licenses authorizing both "possession only-permanent shutdown" [program codes 03800, 11800, and 23300] and the "standby-no operations" [03810, 11810, 23310] that are not in any of the licenses which currently authorize "storage only." These PG 1-27 changes include specified language for the authorized use condition in Item 9 of the licenses, and a license term of two years. Also, PG 1-27 requires the addition of a license condition to the "possession only-permanent shutdown" licenses. We understand that we need not amend any of the "storage only" licenses at this time. A copy of this memo will be placed in the file for each of the licenses on the attached list, and we will amend these licenses to meet the criteria of PG 1-27 at the time of the next renewal.
