AND INDIAN POINT NUCLEAR GENERATING UNIT NO. 3 (TAC NOS.
MA8948 AND MA8949)

On April 27, 2000, representatives of the Power Authority of the State of New York (PASNY) and Entergy, Inc. met with the staff to discuss the sale of the FitzPatrick and Indian Point 3 nuclear power plants to Entergy. PASNY and Entergy stated that among their mutual objectives were continued safe operation of both plants and a sale agreement that will ensure that PASNY continues to meet its commitment to government and business customers.

Under the sale agreement, nuclear employees at both plants and at the PASNY nuclear offices in White Plains, New York, would be offered positions with Entergy. The sale agreement would also leave PASNY in charge of the decommissioning funds. The staff informed PASNY and Entergy that leaving the decommissioning funds under PASNY control might require specific approval by the Commission.

PASNY and Entergy stated that they intended to submit their application on May 12, 2000, which they did. PASNY and Entergy stated that they would like to have the transfer approved by September 2000. The staff informed them that a more realistic date would be about 6 months from receipt of the transfer request.
