The NRC has evaluated the information you provided and determined that no further action is warranted and no violation occurred, pursuant to 10 CFR Parts 50 or 55. The information supplied will be maintained in an NRC Privacy Act System of Records (NRC-16) and will be withheld from release in accordance with the conditions specified in the Privacy Act (5 USC 552a).
