**APPLICANT'S AND STATE OF UTAH'S JOINT
REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF THE
DEPOSITION SCHEDULE FOR CONTENTION UTAH L**

Private Fuel Storage ("Applicant" or "PFS") and the State of Utah ("State") jointly request the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Licensing Board" or "Board") to modify the existing schedule for some of the depositions of PFS's and the State's witnesses for Contention Utah L. In the Board's Memorandum and Order (Granting Joint Request to Extend Discovery Period) of September 20, 2000, the Board extended the deposition window for Applicant's and State's Utah L witnesses to October 30, 2000. Counsel for PFS and the State have been diligently taking depositions of Utah L witnesses up to this point and by the end of the day will have completed depositions of eight of the 12 expert witnesses for Utah L. However, the father of the attorney for PFS who had prepared to take and defend the depositions of the remaining four witnesses scheduled for October 26 and 27¹ has passed away and thus the attorney will be unable to take and defend the depositions. Counsel for PFS and the State have conferred and

verified dates when the four remaining witnesses will be available. Counsel respectfully request that the Board modify the deposition schedule to allow the depositions to be taken on November 15 to 17. Counsel for PFS has conferred with counsel for the NRC Staff and has been advised that the Staff does not object to this motion.

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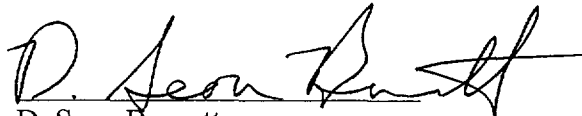
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
