In a letter to you dated June 6, 2000, Mr. Christopher Nolan of the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) explained that the NRC was consulting the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding your concerns about certain evacuation routes near Arkansas Nuclear One (ANO).
