
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A recently completed internal audit of the Environmental Protection Plan identified that 30 day notifications to NRC had not been made for the following proposed or approved changes to LaSalle's NPDES Permit. We requested, in Reference (1), a revision of LaSalle's NPDES permit, Special Condition 13, to extend the chlorination period for the treatment of circulating water. We requested in Reference (2), that a provisional variance be granted effective July 30, 1999, for a period of 45 days. This request was retracted prior to its approval. In Reference (3), the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency transmitted final approval for 5 year renewal (and modification) of NPDES Permit IL0048151, effective May 1, 1999. We requested, in Reference (4), changes to oil and grease sampling frequency and an alternate route for discharge of clean condensate flushing and maintenance. In Reference (5), the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency transmitted final approval for 5 year renewal (and modification) of NPDES Permit IL0048151. This condition has been entered into the corrective action program.

The current LaSalle National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit was approved by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency on September 12, 2000, and a copy is attached. The permit incorporates the subject changes in References 1 through 5.
