AFFIDAVIT

I, Bill Ferdinand, being duly sworn and state as follows:

(1) I am the General Manager at the Smith Ranch Facility, Rio Algom Mining Corp. (RAMC), Converse County, Wyoming. I am duly authorized and delegated the function of reviewing the information described in paragraph (2) and I am hereby requesting that it be held as "CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPIETARY" information.

(2) The information requested to be withheld and considered "CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPIETARY" was provided to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on May 15, 2000, by cover letter dated May 15, 2000, from Mr. Bill Ferdinand (RAMC, General Manager) to Mr. Michael Layton (US. NRC), noting hand delivery of the information to NRC.

Rio Algom Mining Corp. as previously noted in the letter accompanying the materials given to US. NRC on May 15, 2000, requests that the plant layout, process flow, piping and instrumentation, and the typical electrical drawings be withheld and maintained as "CONFIDENTIAL AND PROPIETARY" pursuant to all applicable Federal statutes and regulations. The research, development, engineering, and analytical costs comprise a substantial investment of time and money by Rio Algom Mining Corp.

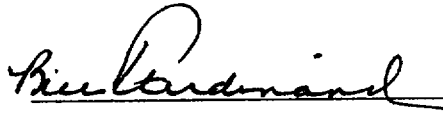

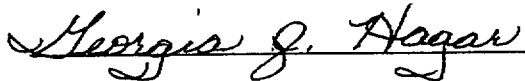
