SUBJECT: ORDER CONFIRMING LICENSE COMMITMENTS ON EMERGENCY RESPONSE
CAPABILITY (GENERIC LETTER 82-33)

The Commission issued an Order on June 12, 1984, confirming Consolidated Edison's commitments on emergency response capability. This Order was based on commitments contained in your letter dated April 15, 1983, as supplemented August 31, 1983, November 18, 1983, February 14, 1984 and March 12, 1984. Your letters were submitted in response to the NRC's Generic Letter 82-33 dated December 17, 1982.

One of the post-TMI actions included in this Order dealt with the implementation of Regulatory Guide 1.97 with respect to Emergency Response Facilities. The attachment to the Order (Item 3.b) stated that implementation would be complete by December 1985. With respect to this item, the Order did not accurately reflect your commitment date as documented in your submittal of April 15, 1983 which we had reviewed and found acceptable.

We are enclosing a corrected table of the schedule contained in the Commission's Order to confirm your commitment to submit a schedule for implementation by December 1985.
