Dear Mr. Cahill:

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has issued Facility Operating License No. DPR-64 to the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. for the Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3. The license is issued pursuant to the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's Order dated April 8, 1975, and the Commission's Memorandum and Order dated December 2, 1975, copies of which have already been sent to you. The license authorizes you to load fuel and perform subcritical tests (but at no time shall the reactor be made critical following fuel loading) in accordance with the provisions of the license and the Technical Specifications. Changes in the Technical Specifications may be made only when authorized by the Commission in accordance with the provisions of Section 50.59 of 10 CFR Part 50. This license shall expire six months from the date of issuance unless extended for good cause or upon earlier issuance of a subsequent licensing action.

A copy of the license, complete with Technical Specifications, and a related notice, which has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication, are enclosed for your information.

Two signed copies of Amendment No. 17 to Indemnity Agreement B-19, which covers the activities authorized under License No. DPR-64, are enclosed for review and acceptance. Please sign and return one copy of the Agreement to this office.

Also enclosed are two copies of Supplement No. 2 to the Safety Evaluation Report prepared by the Division of Reactor Licensing concerning Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 3. Additional copies will be forwarded to you under separate cover.
