SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF June 13-14, 2006, PUBLIC MEETING AND WORKSHOP
ON DRAFT REGULATORY GUIDE (DG-1145), COMBINED LICENSE
(COL) APPLICATIONS FOR NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS
(LIGHT WATER REACTOR EDITION)

On June 13-14, 2006, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with approximately **75 combined license (COL) application stakeholders in a public meeting and** workshop to discuss the development of the draft regulatory guide (RG), DG-1145, "Combined License Applications for Nuclear Power Plants (LWR Edition)."

During the meeting, the staff discussed specific sections of the RG that have been placed on the NRC web site as work-in-progress documents:

- (1) Section C.I.1, "Introduction and General Description of Plant;"
- (2) Section C.I.2, "Site Characterization;"
- (3) Section C.I.3.1, "Conformance with NRC General Design;"
- (4) Section C.I.3.2, "Classification of Structures, Systems, and Components;"
- (5) Section C.I.3.3, "Wind and Tornado Loadings;"
- (6) Section C.I.3.4, "Water Level (Flood) Design;"
- (7) Section C.I.3.5, "Missile Protection;"
- (8) Section C.I.3.6, "Protection Against Dynamic Effects Associated with Postulated Rupture Piping;"
- (9) Section C.I.13.5, "Plant Procedures;"
- (10) Section C.I.15, "Transient and Accident Analyses;" and,
- (11) Section C.II.1, "Probabilistic Risk Assessment."

The staff also discussed the level detail needed to be provided in a COL application. The staff solicited comments and questions throughout the meeting. Questions submitted to the staff on DG-1145 will be posted on the NRC website. It is the staff's intent to develop responses to these questions and compile all the questions received prior to the issuance of DG-1145 for review and comment. The questions will be published in Section C.IV of the draft RG.
