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Mr. John Passehl,

At approximately 9:50 am, I contacted Patrick Whalen at your office to discuss a scheduled falloff test not conducted for the Morton 1-20 Class I injection well under UIC Permit 09-054, Facility Number WYS-009-011. During a records review conducted on February 6, 2012, Cameco Resources discovered that a falloff test scheduled to be conducted August of 2011 was not done on this Class I well. The annual pressure falloff test is a permit condition under Section I of the UIC Permit 09-054. With this discovery, Cameco Resources has discontinued the use of the well until a falloff test is completed.

Cameco Resources would like to schedule a falloff test for this well as soon as possible. Patrick stated he would get back with us after contacting you to acknowledge how soon we can do this test.

As a condition under our NRC Source Material License SUA 1548, a verbal notification to Mr. Doug Mandeville of the NRC was given at approximately 3:20 pm in reference to this event.

Please contact me if you have any questions or comments to when we may proceed with a falloff test.
