INSTRUMENTATION AND CONTROL

On September 1, 2, and 15, 2010, Category 1 public meetings were held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and representatives of the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) at NRC Headquarters, One White Flint North, 11555 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. The purpose of the meetings was to discuss the NRC staff's questions and comments on the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant Unit 2 Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), Section 7 Instrumentation and Control, in support of TVA's application for an operating license.

The meetings consisted of the NRC staff and TVA staff discussing the outstanding open items for the review of Section 7 to the FSAR. In each meeting the NRC staff and TVA staff discussed the level of documentation required by the NRC staff to complete the safety review, specifically for the review of Common Q PAMS. The list of open items discussed can be found in Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession No. ML102880406.
