Subject: Delegation of Authority

This is to confirm your interim appointment as Radiation Safety Officer for the Fletcher Allen Health Care medical use license and blood irradiator license for the period April 6, 2012 through May 2, 2012. You are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management of situations where staff are not cooperating and not addressing radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise Issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend approximately 35% of your time conducting radiation protection activities.
