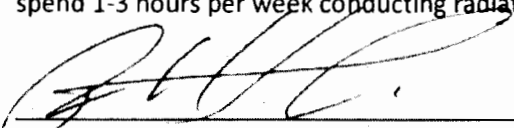

Subject: Delegation of Authority

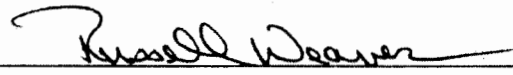
You, Russell Weaver, have been appointed radiation safety officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the Radiation Protection Program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations, when justified, to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend 1-3 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.

In that case, please submit a signed and dated letter stating that you are amending your license renewal application to appoint Michael Silsby as the Radiation Safety Officer on the license. The current request on the record is for yourself to be named as Radiation Safety Officer.

Additionally, the Radiation Safety Officer training certificate was provided for Mr. Silsby, but because that training is provided online we need additional verification that he has had practical and hands-on training using portable gauges in accordance with the attached NRC guidance document. A copy of his authorized user training certificate will likely be sufficient to meet this requirement.

Please only send the letter formally requesting the change of requesting Michael Silsby be listed as the radiation safety officer and his additional training certificate. Please do not send a full application.

Hello Russell,

I received the requested information yesterday and need additional clarification on who is being appointed as the Radiation Safety Officer on this license. The Delegation of Authority letter received appoints Michael Silsby as the Radiation Safety Officer, but Item No. 7 on your submitted application states that you will be the Radiation Safety Officer and Mr. Silsby will be an assistant Radiation Safety Officer. For reference, assistant Radiation Safety Officers are not named on NRC licenses and supporting documentation such as training records or a delegation of authority letter for these individuals are not required for processing the licensing action.

If you are the individual to be named as Radiation Safety officer please provide a new Delegation of Authority appointing you to the position (example attached). If Michael Silsby should be named as the Radiation Safety Officer please provide a statement with a signature and date to confirm that is the case. Additionally, if Michael Silsby is to be appointed as Radiation Safety Officer I need a training record that verifies hands on training; his Radiation Safety Officer training certificate was provided in your first application and is not required to be sent again.
