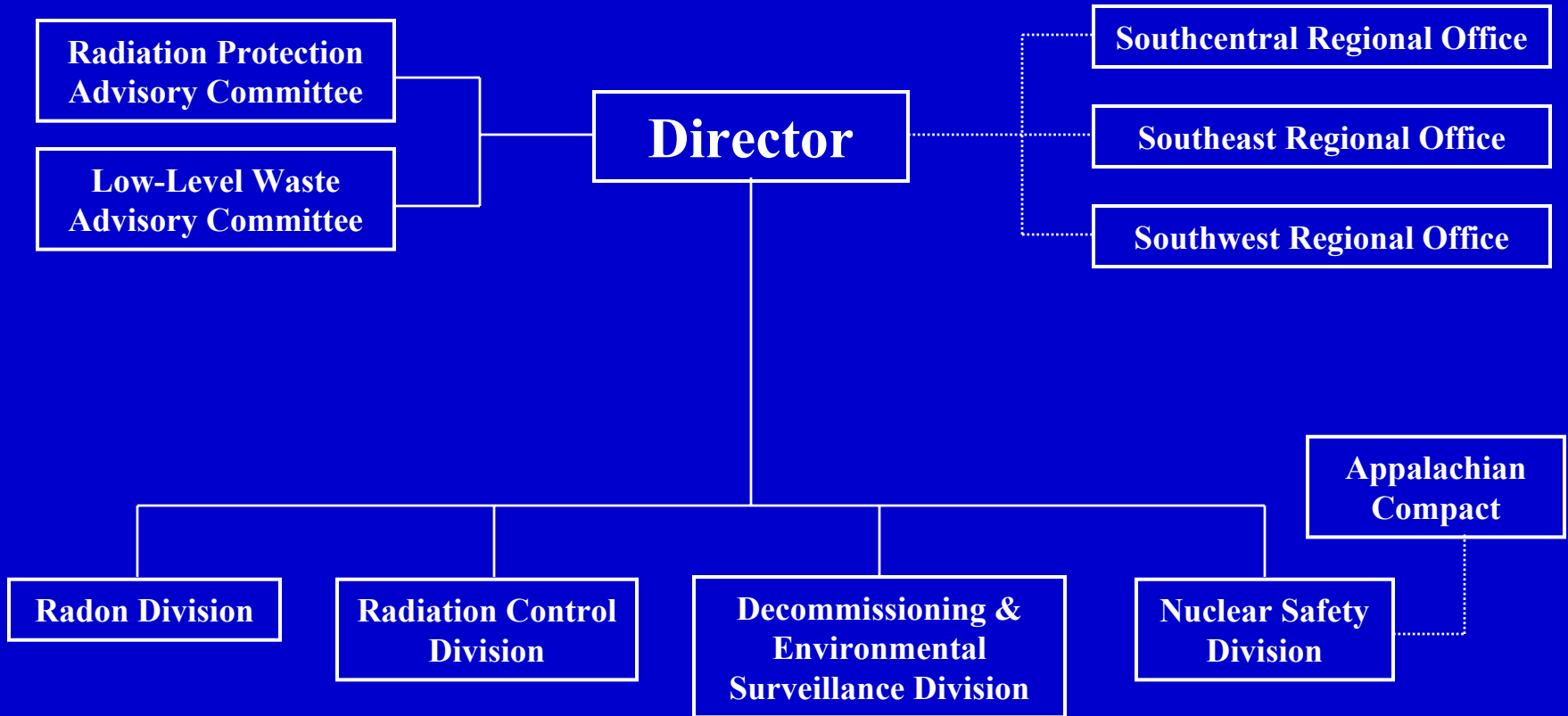

Overview of BRP Post-9/11 Security Activities

- **Provided recommendations to the Governor's Task Force on Security**
- **Developed a Security Communications Protocol, in coordination with PEMA and the PA nuclear utilities**
- **Developed a security readiness checklist**
- **Developed a plan for continuity of operations**

- **Established requirements for the escort of HRCQ RAM transportation**
- **Developed the PA Radiological Assistance Program (PaRAP)**
- **Reviewed and forwarded NRC security advisories and orders for nuclear plants and other licensees**
- **Conducted on-site review of DBT security enhancements at PA nuclear power plants**

- **Continue to acquire equipment and vehicles to enhance radiological emergency response capabilities**
- **Continue to provide training to local emergency responders and law enforcement agencies**
- **Continue to improve data transfer capabilities from PA nuclear power plants to state EOC and RAC**
- **Continue to make improvements to the BRP E-Plan**

BRP Issues and Concerns

- **Consistency in sharing information on materials licensees – Agreement vs. non-Agreement States**
- **Access to ADAMS via a secure password protection interface**
- **Federal participation in integrated response activities with various state and local governments**

- **Sharing information with states on NRC evaluation of security plans and ROP security findings**
- **Sharing information with states on NRC vulnerability assessment and consequence analysis**
- **Nuclear power plant security and law enforcement agency interface**
- **Communications among federal agencies (i.e., DHS and NRC)**

BRP Key Messages

- **States are active partners in security matters**
- **Effective and timely information-sharing provides for adequate preparedness and response**
- **Resolve common issues or concerns through ongoing communication and cooperation**
