- **Percentage of events selected for further communication or action – IAEA**

Why did I select this measure?

- **Because it relates to what I believe is the most important attribute of safety culture**
 - Learning Organization
- **But also supports information on**
 - Accountability
 - Integration of safety into all activities
 - Safety is a recognized value



How has this measure been validated?

- **Still in development**
- **Potential for convergent validity**
