

Dr. Réocreux

Dr. Michel Réocreux graduated from the Ecole Centrale de Paris and received his PhD in two phase flow thermalhydraulics from a university in Grenoble, France. Dr. Réocreux entered the French Safety Institute (IRSN, formerly the IPSN) in the mid 70's, where he has worked for more than 30 years. While at the IRSN, Dr. Réocreux has led safety research programs in the fields of thermalhydraulics, fuel behavior (PHEBUS LOCA program), and severe accident strategies surrounding severe fuel damage and fission product behavior. Dr. Réocreux has played an active role (often as chairman) in several international working groups, namely in the European Communities, the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development, and the Committee on the Safety of Nuclear Installations. He is currently continuing as Scientific Advisor for the IRSN.
