

Biography: Richard F. Dudley, Jr.

Mr. Dudley began his career in 1974 with the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission which later became the U.S. Department of Energy. In 1981 he joined the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission as an operating reactor project manager. Over the last 25 years with the NRC, Mr. Dudley has held a number of different project management and supervisory assignments. He is currently assigned as a senior rulemaking project manager and has worked on the Risk-Informed Emergency Core Cooling Requirements rule (§ 50.46a) since early 2004.

Mr. Dudley holds a Bachelors of Science degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Maryland and a Masters of Science degree in mechanical engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology.
