

Eugene S. Grecheck is Vice President Nuclear Support Services for Dominion Generation. His organization is responsible for providing support to Dominion's 7 nuclear units in Virginia, Connecticut and Wisconsin. These responsibilities include nuclear security, training, licensing and regulatory interface, emergency planning, industrial safety, and operational support.

Grecheck is also responsible for Dominion's new nuclear plant activities; including the application Dominion has filed with the NRC for an Early Site Permit at the North Anna site. Dominion is also currently working, under a cooperative agreement with the Department of Energy, to develop a COL application for a GE ESBWR at the North Anna site.

Grecheck received a BS degree in Physics and an MS in Nuclear Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute. He earned an MBA from Virginia Commonwealth University and also completed The Executive Program at the Darden Graduate School of the University of Virginia. He was licensed by the NRC as an SRO at the Surry Power Station.

His 31-year career with Dominion has included a wide variety of leadership positions at three of Dominion's nuclear stations as well as the corporate offices in Richmond.
