

Ms. Sarah Lynch is currently a Senior Analyst at the U.S. Government Accountability Office (GAO). She works as a project manager and supervisor in GAO's Natural Resources and Environment Team. Ms. Lynch recently completed a review requested by the Senate Subcommittee on Oversight of Government Management, the Federal Workforce, and the District of Columbia (Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs) entitled *Human Capital: Retirements and Anticipated New Reactor Applications Will Challenge NRC's Workforce* from whose findings she will base most of her comments and presentation. Ms. Lynch has recently begun another related new reactor licensing review further evaluating NRC's readiness. At GAO, before conducting NRC-focused work, Ms. Lynch contributed to several evaluations related to U.S. reconstruction efforts in Iraq; post-9/11 vulnerabilities; and U.S. anti-money laundering efforts.
