

Mamoru Ishii, Ph.D.

Purdue University

Mamoru holds a B.S. from Yokohama National University, M.S. from New York University, and a Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering from Georgia Tech. From 1972 to 1974 he was a visiting scientist at the Grenoble Nuclear Research Center and from 1974 to 1988, a Senior Scientist and Group Leader of the Reactor Analysis and Safety Division at Argonne National Laboratory. For the past ten years, Mamoru has been a professor at Purdue University. He has authored more than 120 journal papers in reactor thermal-hydraulics and two-phase flow areas and was the past Chair of American Nuclear Society Thermal-Hydraulics Division
