

Mr. Thomas Martin has over 30 years experience in nuclear power. He began his career with 5 years in the nuclear navy. Before coming to the NRC in 1983, he worked for General Public Utilities at Three Mile Island in support of the post-accident activities and with Pennsylvania Power and Light Company involved with the construction and initial operation of the Susquehanna Nuclear Station.

Mr. Martin has held a variety of positions with the NRC at the NRC Headquarters in Rockville and at the NRC Region III Office in Lisle, Illinois. He has had assignments in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement (since dissolved) as a headquarters based inspector, in the Office of the Executive Director for Operations as the Chief of the Regional Operations Staff, in Region III as a senior manager, in the Office of Research managing rulemaking and generic safety issues, and in the Office of Administration as the Director of Facilities and Security. Mr. Martin is currently the Director of the Division of Safety Systems in the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. His division performs systems-related safety evaluations of licensee implementation of NRC requirements, evaluates proposed changes to existing licenses, and provides related technical support and expertise. Mr Martin is also a member of the NRC Incident Response Team for reactor safety.

Mr. Martin has a Masters Degree in Nuclear Engineering from the University of Virginia and a Bachelors Degree in Ocean Engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy. He is a licensed Professional Engineer.
